2) Collection and storage of personal data as well as kind and purpose of their use

a) When visiting the website

When you visit our website http://www.wowbasicincome.net, the browser used on your device automatically sends information to the server of our website. This information is temporarily stored in a so-called log file. The following information is collected without your intervention and stored until it is automatically deleted:

- IP address of the requesting computer,
- Date and time of access,
- Name and URL of the retrieved file,
- Website from which access is made (referrer URL),
- Browser used and, if applicable, the operating system of your computer as well as the name of your access provider.

The data mentioned will be processed by us for the following purposes:

- To ensure a comfortable use of our website.
- Evaluation of system safety and stability,
- Use on our homepage and/or through social networks,
- for other administrative purposes.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 Para. 1 S.1 lit. a. and b. DSGVO. Our justified interest follows from the purposes listed above for the collection of data. Under no circumstances do we use the collected data for the purpose of drawing conclusions about your person. We also use cookies and analysis services when you visit our website. You will find more detailed explanations under point 4 of this data protection declaration.

b) When using our contact e-mail addres

If you have any questions, we offer you the possibility to contact us via our e-mail address. A valid e-mail address is required. Further information can be provided at will.

Data processing for the purpose of establishing contact with us is carried out in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. a. DSGVO on the basis of your own voluntary consent

3) Data disclosure

Your personal data will not be transferred to third parties for purposes other than those listed below. We will only pass on your personal data to third parties:

- if the disclosure according to Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. b. DSGVO is necessary for the fulfilment of contractual relationships and/or for the implementation of pre-contractual arrangements and if there is no reason to assume that you have an overriding legitimate interest in not passing on your data,
- in the event that there is a legal obligation to pass on data according to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. c DSGVO, and
- this is legally permissible and required for the execution of contractual relationships with you according to Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. b DSGVO.

4) Cookies

We use cookies on our site. These are small files that are automatically created by your browser and stored on your device (laptop, tablet, smartphone, etc.) when you visit our site. Cookies do not cause any damage to your device and do not contain viruses, Trojans or other malware.

Information is stored in the cookie, which results in each case in connection with the specifically used device. This does not mean, however, that we will immediately become aware of your identity.

The use of cookies serves on the one hand to make the use of our website more pleasant for you. For example, we use so-called session cookies to recognize that you have already visited individual pages on our website. These are automatically deleted after leaving our site.

In addition, we also use temporary cookies to optimise user-friendliness, which are stored on your device for a specific period of time. If you visit our site again in order to make use of our services, it is automatically recognised that you have already been with us and which entries and settings you have made in order not to have to enter them again.

On the other hand, we use cookies in order to statistically record the use of our website and to evaluate it for the purpose of optimising our offer for you. These cookies enable us to automatically recognize that you have already visited our site when you visit it again. These cookies are automatically deleted after a defined period of time.

The data processed by cookies are used for the named purposes to protect our legitimate interests as well as those of third parties in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 S. 1 lit. b. DSGVO.

Most browsers automatically accept cookies.

However, you can configure your browser so that no cookies are stored on your computer or a message always appears before a new cookie is created. The complete deactivation of cookies may, however, result in you not being able to use all the functions of our website.

5) Affected rights

You have the right:

- to request information about your personal data processed by us in accordance with Art. 15 DSGVO. In particular, you may request information on the processing purposes, the category of personal data, the category of recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the planned storage period, the existence of a right of rectification, deletion, restriction of processing or objection, the existence of a right of complaint, the origin of your data, unless it has been collected from us, as well as the existence of an automated decision-making process including profiling and, where applicable, meaningful information on its details;
- in accordance with Art. 16 DSGVO to immediately request the correction of incorrect or incomplete personal data stored by us;
- to demand the erasure of your personal data stored by us in accordance with Art. 17 DSGVO, unless the processing is necessary to
 exercise the right to freedom of expression and information, to fulfil a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or to assert,
 exercise or defend legal claims;
- to demand the restriction of the processing of your personal data in accordance with Art. 18 DSGVO if the correctness of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful but you refuse its deletion and we no longer need the data but you need it to assert, exercise or defend legal claims or you have lodged an objection against the processing in accordance with Art. 21 DSGVO;
- in accordance with Art. 20 DSGVO, to receive your personal data which you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format or to request transmission to another responsible person;
- in accordance with Art. 7 para. 3 DSGVO to revoke your consent once given to us at any time. The consequence of this is that we may no longer continue the data processing based on this consent for the future, and
- to complain to a supervisory authority pursuant to Art. 77 DSGVO. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority at your usual place of residence or workplace or at our company headquarters.

6) Right of objection

If your personal data are processed on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 according to F DSGVO, you have the right, pursuant to Art. 21 DSGVO, to object to the processing of your personal data if there are reasons for doing so which arise from your particular situation or which are directed against direct advertising. In the latter case, you have a general right of objection, which is implemented by us without stating a particular situation.

7) Data security

We use the most common SSL (Secure Socket Layer) method in connection with the highest level of encryption supported by your browser. As a rule, this is a 256-bit encryption. If your browser does not support 256-bit encryption, we use 128-bit v3 technology instead. You can tell whether an individual page of our website is transmitted in encrypted form by the closed representation of the key or lock symbol in the lower status bar of your browser.

We also use suitable technical and organisational security measures to protect your data against accidental or intentional manipulation, partial or complete loss, destruction or against unauthorised access by third parties. Our security measures are continuously improved in line with technological developments.
